D. WORK SESSION DISCUSSION:

A. Resolution Copper Company Amendment Mutual Benefits Contract

Mayor Hing addressed that the work session was to discuss how to use the \$100,000 from Resolution Copper Company.

Councilmember Lynn Heglie suggested that the funds be used to buy police cars and the remainder be used on other social programs.

Councilmember Peralta stated that she was in agreement for funds to go police cars but she wanted to see the funds be used on the library. She stressed her concern about the library being in poor condition.

Lieutenant Mike Campbell explained the why the Town is in need of new patrol cars. He gave a break down on four police vehicles.

Mayor Hing asked the Lieutenant which vehicle he would go with if only one was granted until later in the year.

Lieutenant Campbell stated that the 4x4 would be the most efficient.

Vice-Mayor Lopez was also in agreement for the patrol cars and library as well as Mr. Aguilar.

Public Comments:

1. Fred Miramon

Mr. Miramon suggested that the funds be used on park improvements. He stressed how old the equipment. He stated that the children are our community and they need more.

2. Charlene Orlick

Ms. Orlick was in agreement about the library. She stated that it needs serious repair and access to the lower level.

3. Cindy Scholfeld

Ms. Scholfeld from CAAG commented on other grants that could be used to help with the library. She answered the Mayor's question about the cost of just an elevator itself would run about \$15,000. She also answered Ms. Peralta's question on full installation of an elevator would be and that was \$40,000.

4. Pam Rabago

Ms. Rabago asked the Council to consider helping the Chamber of Commerce. They need funds to help with fundraising.

5. Roy Chavez

Mr. Chavez expressed his concern about the way the agenda had been posted and that the public should be more informed so they could comment on how they feel funds should be used. He also stated his concern of why patrol cars were being used by officers to drive home.

6. Sonnie Samson

Mr. Samson asked if the Town was going to consider fixing Town Hall or whether the trailer was going to be used for the next two years.

7. Manuel Ortega

Mr. Ortega stated that there should be more advertising to the public.

8. Martin Navarrette

Mr. Navarrette expressed that the Town should consider a Sports Park. He explained that he is tired of having to drive out of town to take his kids to be involved in extracurricular activities.
