**A: CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Hing called the work session to order at 5:16pm

**B: SALUTE TO THE FLAG:**

Mayor Hing led the council, staff and audience in the pledge of allegiance.

**C: OPENING PRAYER:**

Mayor Hing led the council, staff and audience in the pledge of the opening prayer.

**D: ROLL CALL:**

**Members Present:** Council members Gutierrez, Peralta, Tomerlin, Vice Mayor Lopez and Mayor Hing. Absent: Higlie, Aguilar

**E: DISCUSSION:**

1. Discussion began with several different cities defining the cost of Cemetery fees and miscellaneous fees. Cities include; Tucson, Coolidge, Mammoth, Eloy, Pinal, Florence, Mesa, and Globe, as a reference guide to what the current prices are in Superior.
2. Several ideas were discussed regarding the Town of Superior cost for cemetery plot purchases and open/close, regarding how to identify residents, non-residents and those who would be considered as residents depending how long they lived in the Town of Superior.
3. There were many ideas regarding the current prices and new EPA standards that would soon be in effect, so current cost to purchasers would increase. So discussions on new price ideas were; different prices for resident, non-resident, and resident with ties to the community, each cost would vary, a separate idea, spreading the cost across the board at one flat rate and still others were trying to cut down on miscellaneous cost i.e. clean-up and maintenance of the cemetery, possibility of a Memorial wall and a cemetery niche. The final word was to keep it simple and straight forward, which would eliminate future loop holes.
4. An analysis, to find the cost solution, would be to look at the current plots that have been purchased, how many spaces are left and how much land can be utilized. Until these figures are acquired, the council could not take action.
